



Concrete Stone Corp. and GETO Form Strategic Partnership for P1.36-Billion Manufacturing Facility in Bataan

Concrete Stone Corp. (CSC), an affiliate of Asiabest Group Inc., has entered into a joint venture with China's Jiangxi GETO New Materials Corp. Ltd. to establish a ₱1.36-billion manufacturing facility in Mariveles, Bataan.

The partnership will develop a **40,000-square-meter industrial complex** dedicated to producing advanced formwork systems, catering to the growing needs of the Philippine construction and infrastructure sectors.

The project will be managed by two newly created corporations:

- CSC-GETO Realty Corp. (CGRC) overseeing property development
- GETO-CSC Formworks Inc. (GCFI) handling the facility's operations

Under the agreement, CSC will provide the land and lead operations, while GETO will bring in world-class technology, expertise, and equipment. CSC is also slated to become a subsidiary of Asiabest Group International Inc. by the second quarter of 2026.

"We are setting the stage for a transformative industrial project that will boost local employment and enhance construction efficiency," said **Francis Lloyd Chua**, Chairman of Concrete Stone Corp.

Lian Jie, General Manager of GETO International, added, "This partnership will establish a production hub that not only supports the Philippines but also serves the broader ASEAN region."

The memorandum of agreement was signed on Tuesday in the presence of Frederick Go, Special Assistant to the President for Investment and Economic Affairs.

Once operational, the facility is expected to generate jobs, introduce advanced building technologies, and strengthen local supply chains—directly supporting the government's housing and infrastructure initiatives.
